NOTABLE HIGHLIGHTS: (double plays, etc.)

The Major Division Reds and Phillies met in a rain delayed postponed dual on NBT Bank Field at Ted Testa Park. The team's pitcher's (8 total) combined for 23 strikeouts and a few spectacular defensive plays from both teams. Notably the Phillies catcher saved a handful of runs on very difficult pitches to stop and Gavin Brown made a few running catches to save tons of runs. The offense for the Phillies was spread amongst multiple players and charged forward in the 1st inning. The Phillies scored 3 runs in the top of the first inning and rattled the starter for the Reds, Liam Madden. A bases clearing triple by Dekin Davis led the charge with 2 RBI and then eventually scoring. However, the performances of the day were displayed by relief pitchers Lennox Eastman and Jaxon Clark, both simmered each offense.

The Reds offense shot back in the 1st scoring 4 runs in the bottom half. A double by Liam Madden drove in a run and then he scored on an RBI single from Miles Bacigulpi. The Reds added a run in the 2nd with some clever base running by Lance Armitage and a base hit by Oliver Parker. The Phillies bounced back with 2 runs in the 4th inning produced by a double from Eli Hilsinger to tie the score. The Reds scratched one across to take the lead in the bottom of the 5th inning. Oliver Parker and Xanden Preston shut the door in the 6th by getting a ground ball (6-3) and then striking out the last two batters.
