NOTABLE HIGHLIGHTS: (double plays, etc.)

The Nationals and Cubs played some outstanding ball in the early stages of the playoffs. The games was played in major back and forth momentum swings and played in exciting fashion.

After jumping out to a 2-0 lead in the first, the Nats then tied things up in the second, and then pounded the scoreboard with four runs in the third to take a 6-2 lead. The Cubs stormed back in the bottom of the third to knot up the game at six runs apiece. The Nats then plated one more in the fifth to jump out 7-6 until the Cubs squared things back up at 7 runs each with a run of their own in bottom half of the fourth inning. After holding the Nationals scoreless in the fifth, the Cubs answered with the final three runs of the game to go up 10-7, which remained the final score.

Mark Ecker came in for relief for the Cubs in a 6-6 ball game in the fourth inning and gave up one run while striking out seven batters in three innings pitched.

The Cubs bats were led by Dan Furze (3 hits), James Greene (2 hits + 3 runs), Owen Coon (2 hits), Cylan Southwick (2 hits, including the go-ahead run in the 5th inning).

The Nationals bats were hot, including a home run blast by Brennan Poole (2x2 w/ BB and 2 runs), a triple by Zach Janeski (2x3 w/ 2 runs), and a double by Ryan Phetteplac. Janeski also flashed made a great catch in left-center.
