Jaxson Clark would get right to work for the Phillies on the mound making a great 1-3 play to start the inning. Julianna Jenne would draw a walk and then Jaxson Clark was able to get Emmy Wilson chase an outside pitch to fly out to the First Baseman. With two outs Kooper Sears had a 0-2 count and swung on low pitch, but the ball got past the catcher. Kooper was able to advance to first, putting Jenne on second. Cam Albright had a 2-2 count and laced a ball to deep center driving in Jenne and Sears to tie the game. Albright was able to reach third with the Phillies trying to get Sears out at the plate. With heads, up baserunning Albright was able to walk off the game from an error made by the Phillies. The Phillies in my opinion played there best baseball towards the end of the season and had an outstanding performance in the playoffs this year. The Giants will continue their quest in the next playoff game against the Nationals Wednesday night at Testa Park.
