The Giants and Indians did not disappoint the fans in the final game of the regular season. In wild walk-off fashion, the Indians took the game in 7 innings on a bases-loaded single by Tristan Milligan. The Indians earned their first win over the Giants and were able to bump their record to 7-6, ending the regular season with the same record as the Giants. It appears like both teams will be back squaring off against each other as the 2nd and 3rd seeds in the playoffs beginning this Saturday.

The Tribe's pitching was outstanding holding the hot-hitting Giants to 2-runs through 5-innings. Kielin Irvine started for the Indians and tossed 3-scoreless innings giving up 2 hits while striking out 4. Jordan Brown then came in to pitch and surrendered 2 runs over 2-innings while striking out 4.

Despite a 6-run lead heading into the 6th inning, the Giants took advantage of back-to-back walks to start the last inning, followed by a huge 2-run triple by Liam Baker. The Giants would then take advantage of a few more walks (1 intentional) and would end up getting big hits from Owen Coon, Eli West, and Tim Forehand. After the Giants tied the game, it appeared as if they had scored the go-ahead run to only have the runner called out for not touching home plate.

After some smooth pitching by Giants pitcher Liam Baker to get a 1-2-3 in the bottom of the 6th, the game was headed to extra innings. Indians pitcher Quinn Dodds came in and followed suit, retiring 3 of the 4 batters she faced while holding the Giants scoreless.

In the bottom of the 7th, the Tribe worked 3 walks to load the bases, and with one out, leadoff batter Tristan Milligan was able to connect on a high fastball and drive the ball through a drawn-in infield. Jason Schermerhorn scored the winning run.

The Giants' bats were led by Coon 3x3 (2 runs and a HR), Forehead 2x3, Parker 2x3.

The Indians' bats were led by C. Milligan 3x3 (2 runs), T. Milligan 2x4, and Schermerhorn with 3 walks and 2 runs, including the winning run.
