LIGHTNING & INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES

A member of the Crown City Little League Board of Directors or their designated representative will serve as "Lightning Monitor" at all CCLL events. The "Lightening Monitor" will monitor the weather and if lightning is determined to be within 6 miles or inclement weather is threatening, will follow these procedures:

- **ONE Long Horn Blast**: Games are *suspended*. Coaches, fans, parents and players will move to the parking lot and enter their vehicles. They will remain in their vehicles until notified of the board's decision via the horn.
- TWO Long Horn Blast: Games are resumed, return to fields.
- THREE Long Horn Blasts: Games are cancelled. Go home and contact your coach about a make-up date.

No one will be permitted to remain on the fields, in the dugouts, on the sidewalks or around the concession building. If lightning or thunder is present, the "Lightning Monitor" on duty will monitor the situation with available technology. We will wait 30 minutes from the last lightning strike before resuming games. The air horn will be kept in the concession stand. Communication will be made with outlying fields as well concerning any suspended, resumed or cancelled games.
